

1 Introduction

This document has been produced on behalf of NHS Property Services with regard to their land holding at the former Goscote Hospital site. The purpose of the document is to supplement representations to the Black Country Core Strategy Issues and Options Consultation produced by Iceni Projects.

The document will firstly provide an overview of the constraints associated with the site, and secondly utilise this information to produce an initial concept plan for the potential redevelopment of the site, detailing a potential layout and indicative capacity.

2 Site Constraints

The site forms part of the former Goscote Hospital, to the north of Walsall. The site is approximately 2Ha in size and has direct access from Goscote Lane.

There are a number of existing uses on site, including the locally listed building which sits close to the western boundary.

The site is bounded to the north by residential properties of Goscote Lane and Dolphin Close and to the east by the Wyrley and Essington Canal. To the south of the site is the Goscote Greenacres community garden.
